What is the procedure for seeking admission in MLZS?

The following steps need to be followed:

- 2. Register your child and obtain the School prospectus along with the admission form from the School office during 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on weekdays and from 9.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. on Saturdays.
- 3. Submit the form with the necessary documents i.e. Birth certificate of the ward, Aadhar Card, School Leaving, Report card, Address proof, Aadhar copy of the Parent and 3 sets of photographs of the ward and the parents.
- 4. Admissions to classes are subject to availability of seats. The Submission of the Application for admission form does not ensure admission to the School.
- 5. The final admission decision will be conveyed to the parents / guardians through phone / mail.

What are the school timings?

Pre-primary Section- Nursery / LKG / HKG 8:30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.

Primary Section – Standard I upwards 8:30 a.m. to 3:10 p.m.

What are the features and activities in this school?

In the Pre Primary, it is activity based learning. The students are exposed to a variety of teaching aids and activities to learn the Skills. Besides the academic activities, students are also engaged in extra-curricular and co-curricular activities like celebration of important National and International Days, Cultural Celebrations, Annual Day, Field Trips etc. They are also trained in several sports like Lawn tennis, Chess, Taekwondo etc

- d. Four Passport size color photographs of the child and two each of the parent.
- e. Health Information Form (on the accompanying form) given by the School.
- f. Caste certificate (if child belongs to reserved category)
- g. Undertaking (if any required)

When can we seek the admission?

The process has already begun for the Academic year 2019-2020.

What are the child safety measures adopted by the school?

The school has implemented measures like CCTV, soft padded play area, separate bus boarding lane, female attendants in buses, SMS alerts to parents for attendance and transport and infirmary for the safety of its students.

Which areas are covered by School Transport?

The school has extensive transport coverage. The routes get re-planned at the start of academic session to optimize travel time for the students. The Bus charges are not included in the Annual School Charges. They are decided at the start of the academic session and are payable in two instalments.
